Our Rules



Our core values are Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility. We use these values as our basic rules. We encourage campers to be caring and honest; to respect themselves, others, and their surroundings; and to be responsible for their own actions. Y Camp is a program, campers unable to follow the rules of respect could lose the privilege of attending camp. Our Mission

The mission of the Randolph County YMCA is to put Christian principles into practice through programs that build healthy spirit, mind, and body for all. We have a daily object lesson (that kids bring in) where we teach Christian principles.

Our Hours:

Camp hours are 7:30 – 5:30, Monday – Friday. Drop off and pick up anytime during those hours, except Tuesday's. We use the Brightwheel App for check-in and check-out. Only those on the registration form can check your camper out. Camp dates are May 27-Aug. 2, 2024.

Our Program



Although all the kids are together at camp, activities are implemented according to age groups when appropriate and necessary. Every age in a child's life is a step up to greater challenges and a new world of experiences. Y Summer Camp helps nurture skills and experiences kids enjoy at their own level. Camp is for kids going into the 1st-8th grades.



Our Skilled Leaders



The YMCA selects camp staff for their maturity and experience. Staff create the nurturing environment your child needs to feel secure and confident. Every camp staff member attends pre-camp training and continues to strengthen his or her abilities throughout the summer. Staff are responsible for transporting campers when inclement weather occurs. All precautions are taken for the safety of each camper.

Our "Bad Weather" Procedures

We will remain at the shelter if it is only raining for a short period. In the case of severe weather or steady rain we will transport campers to the Y. We have also arranged with Winchester High School for emergency situations. If the weather is too severe for campers to be dropped off at Goodrich Park in the morning, we will meet at the Y. You will be notified by 7am through the Brightwheel app.

Our Daily Schedule

Monday, Wednesday, and Friday drop your camper off at **Goodrich Park**, Shelter #1. We will spend the morning doing activities at the park and then spend the afternoon swimming at **Goodrich Pool.** Pick your Camper up at the pool. An afternoon snack is provided for your child.

Tuesday is field trip day. We will leave from **Goodrich Park** at announced times and return to **Goodrich Park** by 5:00 p.m.

Thursday is **YMCA Day.** You will drop your camper off and pick them up at the YMCA where they will do science activities, art projects, and gym games.

Your Role

To enroll your child, complete the registration form and pay the \$30 fee, unless paid in the fall. You must indicate how many days your child will attend with payment due the Friday before services start.

Registration fee (per child)	\$30
Full Time	\$135 per week
Additional FT child	\$90 per week
3-Days	\$90 per week
2- Days	\$70 per week

The weekly fee is non-refundable and ensures your child's spot, regardless of whether they attend all the registered days. Your child will be unable to attend Summer Day Camp if fees exceed one week.
