## Your Role

To register your child, you will need to completely fill out a registration form and pay the \$30 fee (unless it was paid for Kids Club) There will be a weekly message sent where we will ask you to confirm whether your camper will be going on that weeks field trip.

<b>Registration fee (per child)</b>	<b>\$30</b>
<b>Daily rate</b>	<b>\$30/per child</b>
<b>Full Time (4-5 days)</b>	<b>\$120 per week</b>
<b>Additional Children (2 days +)</b>	<b>\$60 per week</b>

Weekly fees are due the Friday services were rendered. Prompt payment is required. Your child will be unable to attend Day Camp if fees exceed one week.

## Your Campers Necessities



Campers need a backpack, water bottle, and sunscreen. They should wear tennis shoes. **NO FLIP-FLOPS.** On swim days they need a swimsuit (one-piece suit/tankini for girls), towel, and any other swimming gear. On Field Trip Day's please have your camper wear the YMCA T-shirt.

**Please DO NOT bring TOYS, TRADING CARDS, or ELECTRONICS.**
