Randolph Central will be providing the lunch program. On the dates it operates, we will go to the school for lunch. On other days, Campers will need a sack lunch.

Your Role

To register your child, you will need to completely fill out a registration form and pay the \$30 fee (unless it was paid for Kids Club) There will be a weekly message sent where we will ask you to confirm whether your camper will be going on that weeks field trip.

Registration fee (per child) \$30

Daily rate \$30/per child

Full Time (4-5 days) \$120 per week

Additional Children (2 days +) \$60 per week

Weekly fees are due the Friday services were rendered. Prompt payment is required. Your child will be unable to attend Day Camp if fees exceed one week.

Your Campers Necessities



Campers need a backpack, water bottle, and sunscreen. They should wear tennis shoes. NO FLIP-FLOPS. On swim days they need a swimsuit (one-piece suit/tankini for girls), towel, and any other swimming gear. On Field Trip Day's please have your camper wear the YMCA T-shirt.

Please DO NOT bring TOYS, TRADING CARDS, or ELECTRONICS.

Our Rules

Our core values are Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility. We use these values as our basic rules. We encourage campers to be caring and honest; to respect themselves, others, and their surroundings; and to be responsible for their own actions. Values like these will help your child make good choices no matter what adventure and challenges lie ahead. Y Camp is a program, not childcare. Our Hours: Drop off & Pick up

Camp hours are from 7:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. Monday – Friday. You will sign your camper in and out each day, and only those on your registration form will be able to sign your camper out.

Our Program



Although all the kids are together at camp, activities are implemented according to age group when appropriate and necessary.

Every age in a child's life is a step up to greater challenges and a new world of experiences. Y Summer Camp helps nurture skills and experiences kids enjoy at their own level. Camp is for kids going into the 1st_8th grades.



Our Skilled Leaders



The YMCA selects camp staff for their maturity and experience. Staff creates the nurturing environment your child needs to feel secure and confident. Every camp staff member attends pre-camp training and continues to strengthen his or her abilities throughout the summer. Staff are responsible for transporting campers when inclement weather occurs. All precautions are taken for the safety of each camper.

Our "Bad Weather" Procedures

We will remain at the shelter if it is only raining for a short period. In the case of severe weather or steady rain we will transport campers to the Y. We have also arranged with Winchester High School for emergency situations. If the weather is too severe for campers to be dropped off at Goodrich Park in the morning, our rain location will be the Y or the Compass Church, neighboring the Y. You will be notified.

Our Daily Schedule

Monday, Wednesday, and Friday drop your camper off at Goodrich Park, Shelter #1. We will spend the morning doing activities at the park and then spend the afternoon swimming at Goodrich Pool. Pick your camper up at the pool. An afternoon snack is provided for your child.

Tuesday is field trip day. We will leave from **Goodrich Park** and return to **Goodrich Park** by 5:00 p.m.

Thursday is **YMCA Day.** You will drop your camper off and pick them up at the YMCA where they will do science activities, art projects, and gym games.

Swimming Lessons

You must register separately for swim lessons. If you are interested in swimming lessons we will walk your child to the lessons during the 1st session, from 9:30–10:15 a.m. Space is limited.
