PARENTAL PERMISSION & CONSENT FORM **Please provide your initials acknowledging each item below**
I give permission for my child to attend the Randolph County Y Day Camp program from May 30th to August 8th, 2023. I understand there is a \$30 registration fee which is non-refundable. This MUST be paid before my child is considere enrolled for Camp. I agree to pay weekly fees incurred in a timely manner.
Field Trip Permission: I give permission for my child to participate in Field Trips with the Randolph County Y Summer Camp program. I give permission for my child to participate in all scheduled activities, including being at Goodrich Park Swimming and Y Day activities. I will not hold the Randolph County YMCA, its employees or volunteers responsible for any accident, injury or mishap that may occur during any of the activities.
Bus Permission: I give permission for my child to be transported by the Randolph Central School Corporation for field trips and other local activities between the park and the YMCA. I will not hold Randolph Central School Corporation, it employees or volunteers responsible for any accident, injury or mishap that may occur during transportation. In Emergency situations, campers may be transported by staff in their personal vehicles.
Medical Emergency Information: In the event reasonable attempts to contact parents or guardians have been unsuccessful, I hereby give my consent for the administration of any treatment deemed necessary by any licensed physician, and the transfer of the child to any hospital reasonably accessible. This authorization does not cover major surgery, unless the medical opinion of two licensed physicians, concurring in the necessity for such surgery, is obtained prior to the perfor mance of such surgery.
Publicity Permission: I grant the Randolph County YMCA the right to take photographs of my child while participating in Summer Camp activities. I authorize that the Randolph County Y may use and publish the same in print and/or electronically. I agree that the Randolph County Y may use photographs of my child with or without name for any lawful purpose, including for example such purposes as publicity, illustration, advertising, and Web content. I also give permissio for pictures taken during the Y Summer Camp program to be used for Grant purposes and give granting organizations permission to use such photos in promotional material about such grants.

•Each camper will be responsible for his/her own bottle of sunscreen with an SPF of at least 30 in their swi bags with their name in permanent marker.
 Day Camp staff will be responsible for applying sunscreen after lunch, prior to swimming and again at the 2:45 break at the pool. We will apply sunscreen at other times per request.
 We encourage each child to allow a staff person to apply the sunscreen to ensure proper coverage, however, per parent request, we will allow older campers to apply their own sunscreen.

REGISTRATION AND WEEKLY FEES

The YMCA Summer Day Camp is for campers entering 1st-8th grade in the fall. There is a one-time registration fee of \$30 (unless paid when child was enrolled in Kid's Club during the prior school year.) This fee is due with the registration form and will reserve a spot for your camper. It is a non-refundable fee and does not apply to any other costs. Please pay the weekly fees on or before the Friday services are rendered. Your child will not be allowed to attend camp if you are more than one week behind.

Swim lessons during session 1: Our staff will walk them to lessons and remain with them. Campers will receive lessons at members cost. A separate swim registration form is required prior to the 1st day of lessons.
